




Women no longer look like her...




DIRECTOR'S NOTES

The screenplay avoids the biographical approach, which would be impossible with such a complex personality, and becomes a visionary story. I read, remembered, and talked about her; then I forgot her to bring her back to life.

The human story doesn't follow an exact chronology. Every moment that we put under the lens leads to another, and their meanings slowly gains altitude adding: the battles, the victories, the loves, the deceits and the getaway.

And then, the night again.



September 28th, 1973, a letter from Rossellini (excerpt): "An almost shocking love..."

«Cinema people felt that the public had forgotten her but the day of her death the misunderstanding was dispelled. Imagine an immense crowd, from one hundred to one hundred and fifty thousand people, who invaded the streets of the city.

There were people who, as soon as they heard the news of her death, had come from the most remote parts of Italy.

And when the coffin began to advance in the midst of this human tide, the people started clapping with all their strenght.

The public had identified with Anna, a pure Roman heroine, a proud and courageous expression of all Italy"

WHO IS

ANNA MAGNANI – the greatest

Anna Magnani was the greatest female interpreter of our times. A complex figure, but with such a charisma that her name reached the highest peaks of Italian cinema. Symbol of a noble and profound Rome, she is also the first Italian actress to win an Oscar in 1956 with "The Rose Tattoo". Directed by great directors such as Renoir, Mann, Cukor, Lumet, Kramer, in the course of her career she has also won the Golden Bear, the Coppa Volpi, 2 David di Donatello, 5 Nastri d'argento, 2 National Board of Review Awards, the Golden Globe, the British Academy Film Award.

It is a categorical to pay homage to Anna Magnani, an authentic symbol of the post-war Italian cinema, and especially of women's strength, on the occasion of the anniversary of her death occurred in 1973, when Anna was only 65 years old. She passed away after 20 days of agony, assisted by her closest friends, and by her beloved son Luca, born from the relationship with the actor Massimo Serato.

Her unforgettable face continues to live through her famous interpretations in which she tells Italians daily lives, struggles and real needs. This happens when cinema takes the streets and gets in contact with people, giving birth to neorealism, like the protagonist of "Rome Open City" by Roberto Rossellini, manifesto of that revolutionary artistic and cultural movement.
